## Pine Bush Central Schools Announces Kindergarten Registration Details

PINE BUSH-The Pine Bush Central School District is preparing for kindergarten registration and screening for students who will be attending school in the 2010-2011 school year. To receive registration information, parents of eligible children should contact the main office of the elementary school designated for the attendance area in which they reside:

To be eligible for admission:

1. The child must reach the age of five on or prior to December 1, 2010. If the child's birthday falls between September and December, the parent has the option to register the child the following year.
2. An official document verifying the child's date of birth (preferably the child's birth certificate) must be presented. This document must be original (a photocopy will not be accepted).
3. The child must have all necessary immunizations in keeping with New York State law. No child is allowed to enter school without proper immunization. Doctor verification is required. New York State Legislation recommends that students six years of age or younger be screened for lead poisoning.
4. Two proof of residency items are required (i.e. tax bill or rental agreement plus utility bill or telephone bill).
